1. Cantery 1 has been working under cover of a HICOG job which is to be terminated on 21 May. This is a result of an overall cut of US production in force and BOB is unable to arrange his retention locally. Continuation of his present HICOG cover is considered vital and it is imperative that there be no lapse in his employment.

2. It is requested that you contact the Personnel Division in Bonn and arrange for Cantery 1's retention, and if necessary agree to reimburse HICOG for his salary, which amounts to approximately 12,000 DM yearly. **

3. Subject's cover arrangement was approved by Messrs. Shute and Edward Page, Jr. The Chief of his office was advised of the circumstances of his employment and handled the technical details involved in getting him on the payroll. He was also recommended to us (apparently about May 1950) by his chief.
