1. We are forwarding for your files, in case you have not seen it, a copy of the OAI interview with [ ] on 20 January 1952. It will be appreciated if you will send us any NIS names provided by the CAUTERYs as you receive them instead of relying on our receipt of refugee debriefings. If the fact that [ ] worked for the NIS in 1943 and was arrested by NIS Grossenhain in 1950 is new to you, it is suggested that you impress upon CAUTERYs 1 and 4 the necessity for detailed biographic data on all agents at the earliest opportunity. In this connection, please forward any biographic data CAUTERY has obtained on [ ] especially in view of her failure to appear since 2 March.

2. In the [ ] project we need more details on the train story. We can find no train listed in the Antliches Karstuck (valid to 17 May 1952) which leaves the Johann-Georgensadt area between 2245 hours and 1215 the following day. When CAUTERY 1 or 4 goes over this story with [ ] he might also be able to clarify ANATOLII's appearance on the late train, if [ ] remembers having advised her friends in Johann-Georgenstadt or a local "Special Service Office" of her new schedule between the hour of her release and departure time. If she told no one, but took the first train scheduled after the one she missed, ANATOLII might have observed her miss the first one and gone to the station on the chance of finding her on the next one. Did he offer any explanation, or did she ask for one? Did he comment on his reason for going only to Aus instead of continuing to Chemnitz as originally planned? These questions are asked in connection with ANATOLII's offer to "take care of" [ ] troubles with the "MKVD."

3. We would also like to know, for our records, what legend [ ] is prepared to tell ANATOLII in case he asks who translated her letters into Russian.
