Our thanks for the speed and adequacy with which you made arrangements with NICOX on this case. We do not require the assignment of CAUTERY 1 to any specific position, but the type is of considerable importance. He should be free to move around at any time; not bound to his desk for eight hours a day by a routine that must be maintained to cover him. In addition, if he can be put in a slot with any investigative overtones or functions his actual activity will correspond much more closely with his T/C position. With these restrictions noted, we have no preference about the cover designation under which CAUTERY 1 is employed.
