
Our thanks for the speed and adequacy with which you made arrangements with BICCG on this case. We do not require the assignment of CAUTHRY I to any specific position, but the type is of considerable importance. We should be free to move around at any time; not bound to his donk for eight hours a day by a routine that must be maintained to cover him. In addition, if he can be put in a slot with any investigative overtones or functions his actual activity will correspond much more closely with his T/C position. With these restrictions noted, we have no preference about the cover designation under which CAUTERY I is employed.
