A note to paragraph 12 of referenced memorandum indicates our present attitude toward the salaries being paid CAUTERYs-1 and -4. An additional justification for this payment is the fact that they are now involved in refugee debriefing for REDCAP and other purposes. Between now and 30 September 1953, the refugee flow into Berlin will be at its heaviest for this year. When this flow begins to slacken, we will again review the entire CAUTERY project to determine whether or not they should be retained in refugee debriefing or in any other capacity. With this in mind, it is recommended that the project be approved as submitted.
