SUBJECT: GENERAL— CADORY/Operational

SPECIFIC— LCCASSOCK/CAUTERY 1

1. It will be recalled that CAUTERY 1 was formerly handled by [redacted] under the now terminated CAUTERY project. He was thereafter turned over to [redacted] and became the security officer for project LCCASSOCK.

2. In a recent conversation with his case officer, CAUTERY 1 mentioned that he has been maintaining an occasional correspondence with [redacted] which still exists at present. Recently he had received a letter from [redacted] suggesting that at his next opportunity he visit an unidentified American located in Mehlem who apparently represents KUBARK for purposes of maintaining liaison with other American organizations and, perhaps, with German organizations. CAUTERY queried whether or not in such a conversation he should mention his present work for LCCASSOCK. If not, he would avoid the conversation entirely. CAUTERY was advised not to mention his present work, since to do so might lead to misunderstandings of various sorts. CAUTERY noted that he will be guided accordingly.

3. As a matter of general policy, it does not appear that uncoordinated contact with CAUTERY 1 such as that noted above is conducive to his effectiveness in his present position. The normal KUBARK channels are of course available for any communications with him which may become desirable. If it appears, however, that messages must be sent to CAUTERY 1 outside of the normal KUBARK channels, it is requested that we be kept informed. Your cooperation in this respect is appreciated.
