We agree wholeheartedly that the situation described in Reference is operationally undesirable and believe that we should not press our luck that to date no link-up between USBER and LCCASSOCK has been uncovered. It is therefore requested that as soon as the LCCASSOCK picture is sufficiently resolved, L-4 be transferred to LCCASSOCK (or other appropriate action depending on the ultimate future of LCCASSOCK) as soon as operationally feasible.
