SUMMARY OF OPERATIONAL HISTORY: Subject was originally cleared for KUBARK REDCAP work in 1951. At that time he held the position of chief investigator in the Economic Division of HICOG, Berlin. The initial KUBARK contact was made by [redacted] Up until September 1953 Subject debriefed refugees for REDCAP leads. Thereafter he was employed as security officer in the LCCASSOCK project, in which position he has remained to the present. He has continued (by arrangement between HICOG, now USBER, and KUBARK) his overt employment with USBER, but works full time for LCCASSOCK. Due to his advanced years (he is 63), he is not as active as he once was, but he has nevertheless performed well in his LCCASSOCK duties. He has excellent personal connections in local and W. German gov't circles, particularly in the German police and the Bundespost, is by profession an expert criminologist, has a school knowledge of French and English. He has had no specialized
