37. How, when and where was subject first contacted or developed?

Subject was recommended by Leon J. STECK of the Economic Affairs Division of Hicog, Berlin element. He was contacted by [redacted] in 1950, worked for SR Project until 1953 when he was picked up by CADORY.
39. Best estimate of subject's motivation.

Subject is sincerely pro-West politically, optimistic about the eventual solution of European problems the Western way and a moderate German nationalist. From all indications, subject likes his present position and enjoys being in the intelligence field. To the extent that his salary has made it possible for him to arrange for his old age he is financially motivated.
40. With what agencies and files has subject's name been checked? When? Result? What else has been done to verify biographical information furnished by subject?

Subject was traced through EDC, Berlin Base files, COS, ODOPAL, Headquarters internal files in 1953. In 1955 he was checked through Munich, and UPSWING files. He was also checked through ODENVY and ODACID files. All of the above resulted in no derogatory information being developed on subject or on anyone listed in his PRQ. Subject's connection with the July 1944 plot on Hitler's life was verified in denazification records.

43. Explain fully subject's past or present connection with any intelligence service.

Subject claimed at time of hiring that he had had no previous connections with any intelligence service. It is probable, however, that in his capacity with the German criminal police he made professional contacts with the German Abwehr and SD.

There were no indications of dual employment turned up as a result of All-Agency checks.

44. What type of information has subject furnished? What type is he best qualified by education and experience to furnish? Give evaluation of information received.

Subject does not furnish information in his present position beyond operational and security information which is part of his responsibility as project security and investigative officer.

45. If subject's duties are other than intelligence gathering, explain.

Subject functions as ECCASSOCK Security officer. His duties include CI reviews and evaluations of project operation, interviewing personnel for prospective employment, checking new personnel and training them in good security practices, physical security of the ECCASSOCK installation and liaison with police and other security agencies on security and personnel.

None beyond guidance given by case officer in regular meetings.

49. Have any promises or commitments whatsoever (not covered elsewhere in this form) been made to subject? Explain.

None beyond evacuation commitments noted in Agent Bio Data Form.

Subject is entirely reliable insofar as records indicate. He is moderate in his social activity, and lives modestly. He has always appeared honest in his dealings with the case officer and presents his problems in a straightforward manner. His security is for the most part excellent.

Subject was a police official by profession with a great deal of experience and a number of contacts in this field. This could possibly be of value in other operations.
