We have checked BOE/Finance with regard to the salary payment arrangement described in paragraph 5-b of Reference A. Their records disclose no evidence that LCCASSOCK-4's salary has in the past been included in LCCASSOCK obligations. On the contrary, in view of the fact that LCCASSOCK operational obligations have closely approximated the total annual project budget in recent years without allowance for this additional (approximately) DMW 12,000 annual obligation, it would appear that, in practice at least, the LCCASSOCK account adjustment noted in Reference A. was never effected. Before going ahead with the procedural steps involved in LCCASSOCK-4's transfer from USBER to LCCASSOCK employment, we would appreciate COS and Bonn's advice and clarification of this aspect of the problem, per paragraph 5-c of Reference A.
