Proposal that the President Meet with

Bobby Fisher

This is in reply to your recent memorandum to Henry suggesting that perhaps the President should meet with Bobby Fisher before Fisher plays Boris Spassky for the world chess championship.

It is our understanding that the dates and locations for the championship are still not finally decided, but that it is probable that the match will begin on June 21 in Belgrade, Yugoslavia. If this schedule is confirmed, the proposed meeting would appear to be a fine idea. It would be best to schedule the meeting for early June, after the President returns from his Moscow visit.

SUBJECT: Bobby Fisher Mouting with the President

Lacy Winchester has cent a memorandum to Heavy, Alex Butterfield and David Parker (Tab B) suggesting that the Provident might must with chose player Schley Fisher before Fisher plays the Soviet world titlebolder, Borie Speechy, for the world championship.
