REPORT: WORKING GROUP ON ANGOLA

1. The visit of UNITA President Jonas Savimbi to Togo on 11 October 1975 was successful. Togolese President Eyadema volunteered to speak to the heads of state of Niger and Upper Volta on behalf of UNITA.

2. Savimbi has received an invitation from Ghana head of state Colonel Acheampong to visit his country. Savimbi will stop over in Ghana on his return from Paris.

3. Savimbi's visit to Yaounde, Cameroon, does not appear to have been successful. Although President Ahidjo was in Yaounde, he refused to see Savimbi, who was instead met by Prime Minister Paul Biya on 18 October. A brief article in the government-controlled Cameroon Tribune of 21 October mentioned the interview and stated that Cameroon has always stigmatized violence and war and hopes that the three Angolan movements will be reconciliated by 11 November.
