(TEXT) THE THREE ANGOLAN LIBERATION MOVEMENTS HAVE AGREED IN PRINCIPLE TO FORM A PROVISIONAL GOVERNMENT OF NATIONAL UNITY.

THIS WAS DISCLOSED BY THE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE THREE ANGOLAN LIBERATION MOVEMENTS DURING A MEETING LASTING MORE THAN 24 HOURS (FIGURE AS HEARD), CHAIRED BY PRESIDENT AMIN, WHO IS ALSO CHAIRMAN OF THE OAU.

THE REPRESENTATIVES SPELLED OUT THEIR SUBMISSION FROM THE PROPOSAL PUT TO THEM BY MEMBERS OF THE BUREAU OF THE OAU SUMMIT. THE MEETING TOOK PLACE AT THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE CENTER. IT WAS

ATTENDED BY THE OAU SECRETARY GENERAL, DR ETEKI MBOUMOUA, AND OTHER MEMBERS OF THE BUREAU.
