At next convenient opportunity please convey following concerning advance trip:

-- With respect to aircraft communications, neither aircraft nor Guam have C. W. or A. M. capability. Therefore, U. S. side proposes to attempt contact Shanghai from aircraft (call sign: SAM 86971) at Guam on Shanghai Radio frequencies (voice) at 0600 hours, January 3, 1972 (Shanghai time) and thereafter. Aircraft will still be enroute Guam at earlier time proposed for contact by P. R. C.
