SUBJECT: COSTA RICA -- Figueres Agreement with Costa Rican Communist Party Chief

Attached for your information at Tab A is a brief appraisal of the Costa Rican situation [redacted] In essence, he concludes that President Figueres and Manuel Mora, the Secretary General of the Costa Rican Communist Party (PVP), are both having difficulties in implementing their secret agreement. You will recall the agreement provided for PVP support of Figueres in the 1970 elections in return for establishment of diplomatic and trade understandings with the USSR, legalization of the PVP, and placement of PVP members in Government positions.

Figueres is meeting stiff opposition in his attempts to live up to the agreement in both the Legislature and in his own party. Although Figueres' position is threatened, he is being constrained by Costa Rican political institutions. (The Mexican expulsion of five Soviet diplomats also seems to have forced Figueres' hand -- Costa Rica has suspended its discussions with the Soviets regarding the establishment of a diplomatic mission in San Jose.)

Mora's position similarly is not threatened, but the rank and file of the PVP, who are not aware of his agreement with Figueres, are becoming increasingly restive about Mora's support for the Figueres Administration. Mora has opposed their desire for a harder line against Figueres. However, unless he can demonstrate that his support of Figueres has paid off for the PVP, Mora's power may erode.

The report notes that Figueres cannot succeed himself, and there is time pressure on Mora to produce results. However, if Figueres accelerates his attempt to be responsive to Mora, he may well strengthen the hand of his opposition. Thus, both Figueres and Mora seem to have worked themselves into something of a box.
