THE POLES POSITION ON RATIFICATION OF THE WARSAW TREATY WAS: UNCHANGED: WILLMAN SAID, THE WARSAW TREATY "SHOULD NOT BE RATIFIED INDEPENDENTLY FROM THE SOVIET TREATY." THEY PUT NO PRESSURE ON THE GERMANS ABOUT THE PRECONDITION OF A BERLIN SETTLEMENT BEFORE RATIFICATION OF THE MOSCOW TREATY. Ambassador Pauls called today to say that he was very anxious to see you for about twenty minutes. He is available whenever it suits your schedule. I assume he wishes to talk about China. China policy is a continuing issue in Germany although Brandt ruled some time ago that the FRG was to make no attempt to play China off against the USSR. Schroeder has been interested in making a trip. With the US now substantially out ahead of the Germans. Bonn may be considering how to move. All its major allies are in direct contact with Peking.
