be as helpful as we can consistent with our capabilities, but to steer Lanusse clearly toward the international agencies. The difficult question to decide is who we should send.

I understand that State is thinking of recommending someone like David Kennedy or Nat Samuels. However, a high-level Treasury official might be more appropriate in view of Treasury's familiarity with the workings of the international financial agencies. Bob Hormats and I will explore this with Treasury and State and staff this issue for you shortly. In the meantime, I want to flag this problem in the event it is raised with you.
