COMING SO SOON AFTER THE ITALIAN FAILURE TO R ESPOND FULLY TO YOUR PERSONAL APPEAL, A VISIT FROM ANY MEMBER OF YOUR CABINET COULD HAVE BEEN DISASTROUS. IF WE PRETENDED NOTHING HAD HAPPENED TO OFFEND US, MY GREATEST ASSET, WHICH IS YOUR VERY GREAT PERSONAL INFLUENCE HERE, WOULD HAVE BEEN CONSIDERABLY DIMINISHED. IF ANGER AT AND CRITICISM OF THEIR FAILURE TO SUPPORT US HAD BEEN TOO PUBLICLY EVIDENT, IT WOULD HAVE PROVIDED A FIELD DAY FOR THE SOCIALIST AND COMMUNIST PROPAGANDA APPARATUS TO RING ALL THE CHANGES ON THE THEME OF "INTERFERENCE."
