Bud:

Inasmuch as you have been directly involved in this Arab boycott operation ever since Fod Hills first surfaced it several months ago, you understand as well as I that we have never been able to resolve the problem of where primary responsibility resides. This has had the practical effect of leaving the bureaucratic responsibility with Euchen's shop, while we try (sometimes desperately) to keep up with what is happening and ensure that the substanive foreign and economic policy consideratio ere properly represented. On the cuestion of scheduling a meeting with the *resident, Buchenos office has taken the lead and requested the meeting right after receiving Jir. Conners memo with the President's decision to approve it. What form their request to Nicholson took, I do not know but they did associate NSC.As it stands, there will be no meeting before the President returns from Paris, since there is no time on his schedule. We will have a memo presenting options in lieu of the strategy meeting which the President can study on the trip.
