CAIRO: U.S. RECONNAISSANCE PLANES OVERFLY EGYPT

(COMMUNIQUE NO. 34 ISSUED BY THE ARMED FORCES GENERAL COMMAND)

(TEXT) AT 1305, TWO ENEMY RECONNAISSANCE PLANES PENETRATED OUR AIRSPACE FROM NORTH OF PORT SAID AND CONTINUED ON UNTIL NAJ' HAMMADI, WHEN THEY TURNED NORTH TOWARD CAIRO AND EAST TO THE SINAI AREA IN THE DIRECTION OF LEBANON AND SYRIA. THEY THEN TURNED NORTHWEST TOWARD THE MEDITERRANEAN.

THIS FLIGHT OVER THE EGYPTIAN TERRITORIES LASTED 25 MPNUITES. THE TWO PLANES WERE FLYING AT AN ALTITUDE OF 25 KMS AND AT A SPEED OF MACH 3.

THESE PLANES ARE OF THE U.S. SR71A TYPE. IT IS KNOWN THAT THIS TYPE OF AIRCRAFT IS OWNED ONLY BY THE UNITED STATES. THIS IS THE FIRST TIME THAT AN AIRCRAFT OF THIS TYPE HAS PENETRATED OUR AIRSPACE.
