ARAB-ISRAELI CONFLICT, OCTOBER, 1973, INTERNAL SECURITY -  
MIDDLE EAST.

AT 12:35 PM, ON OCTOBER 26, 1973, A CONFIDENTIAL SOURCE, WHO  
HAS FURNISHED RELIABLE INFORMATION IN THE PAST, ADVISED THAT SOVIET  
AMBASSADOR TO THE UNITED NATIONS (UN), YAKOV MALIK, ADVISED UN  
SECRETARY GENERAL KURT WALDHEIM THAT THE PERMANENT REPRESENT-  
ATIVES OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, POLAND AND BULGARIA HAVE CONTACTED  
MALIK, EXPRESSING OFFERS TO SEND CONTINGENTS TO THE UN EMERGENCY  
FORCE FOR THE MIDDLE EAST, AND THESE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVES  
WOULD PROBABLY ASK TO MEET WALDHEIM UNOFFICIALLY REGARDING  
THESE OFFERS.

WALDHEIM STATED THAT HE WOULD TAKE NOTE OF THESE OFFERS  
AND THAT THE MATTER IS "STILL UP IN THE AIR," AND THAT WALDHEIM  
SUGGESTED THIS MORNING DIRECT CONTACT, IN WASHINGTON, TO RESOLVE  
THE SOVIET AND UNITED STATES VIEWPOINTS.

MALIK STATED THAT HE WOULD CONSULT WITH DOBRYNIN, BUT THAT  
IT WAS HIS PRESENT INTENTION, "IF SCALF IS AGAINST THIS," TO  
OBJECT STRONGLY IN THE FORTHCOMING MEETING OF THE SECURITY  
COUNCIL.
