1. TV: KOPPEL, VALERIANI, AND KALB APPEARED ON FILM FROM ISRAEL ON THEIR RESPECTIVE NETWORKS THURSDAY EVENING NEWS SHOWS, ALL INCLUDING FOOTAGE OF SECRETARY'S ARRIVAL STATE-MENT: "I COME HERE NOT TO DISCUSS CONCESSIONS BUT TO DISCUSS SECURITY. THE ISSUE IS NOT PRESSURE BUT A LASTING PEACE." FOLLOWING ARE TEXTS ALL THREE REPORTS:

A. VALERIANI (NBC): "KISSINGER ARRIVED IN ISRAEL AFTER TWO DAYS IN EGYPT. SINCE HIS LAST VISIT THE ISRAELIS HAVE BE-COME INCREASINGLY ANXIOUS ABOUT WASHINGTON'S DEVELOPING FRIENDSHIP WITH THE ARAB WORLD, AND KISSINGER IMMEDIATELY TRIED TO PUT THEM AT EASE ABOUT THE NEGOTATIONS WITH SYRIA.

DESPITE KISSINGER'S REASSURING WORDS THE U.S. POSITION IS THAT ISRAEL WILL PROBABLY HAVE TO MAKE THE FIRST MOVE SINCE IT IS THE ISRAELIS WHO OCCUPY SYRIAN TERRITORY AND THEY WILL THEREFORE HAVE TO DO THE WITHDRAWING. IN JERUSALEM KISSINGER'S FIRST ORDER OF BUSINESS WAS SOCIAL, INTRODUCING HIS WIFE NANCY TO PRIME MINISTER GOLDA MEIR. HE THEN HAD A LONG PRIVATE LUNCH WITH MRS. MEIR AND LATER MET FOR SEVERAL HOURS WITH HER AND OTHER TOP OFFICIALS OF

THE CABINET. INFORMED SOURCES SAY THE ISRAELIS ARE NOW PREPARED TO GIVE UP THE GOLAN HEIGHTS TOWN OF KUNITRA WHICH THEY CAPTURED DURING THE 1967 WAR, AN IMPORTANT FIRST STEP TOWARD NARROWING THE GAP BETWEEN THE ISRAELI AND SYRIAN NEGOTIATION POSITION."

B. KOPPEL (ABC): "SECRETARY KISSINGER KNEW WHAT HE WOULD FIND WHEN HE ARRIVED IN ISRAEL AT LEAST ON THE PUBLIC LEVEL -- SUSPICION THAT HE HAS COME HERE WITH A READY MADE AMERICAN PLAN AND THE FEAR THAT WASHINGTON WILL TRY TO FORCE THAT PLAN ONTO THE GOVERNMENT HERE WITHOUT REGARD TO ISRAELI SECURITY. IN HIS AIRPORT ARRIVAL STATEMENT HE ADDRESSED HIMSELF TO BOTH ISSUES.

BY THE TIME KISSINGER ARRIVED AT HIS HOTEL IN JERUSALEM A SMALL CROWD OF DEMONSTRATERS WAS ON HAND TO URGE HIM NOT TO FORGET THE ISRAELI PRISONERS BEING HELD BY SYRIA. MINUTES AFTER HIS ARRIVAL SECRETARY AND MRS. KISSINGER LEFT FOR A SOCIAL LUNCH AT GOLDA MEIR'S HOME. IT WAS AN OPPORTUNITY FOR KISSINGER TO INTRODUCE HIS WIFE TO THE ISRAELI PRIME MINISTER. BUT EVEN AS THEY CHATTED IN THE GARDEN ANOTHER GROUP OF DEMONSTRATERS FROM THE OPPOSITION GROUP WAS MASSING OUTSIDE.

ISRAELI OFFICIALS POINT OUT THAT THERE ARE SIGNIFICANT DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THIS DISENGAGEMENT WITH SYRIA AND THE ONE THAT KISSINGER NEGOTIATED BETWEEN EGYPT AND ISRAEL. THERE ARE NO ISRAELI SETTLEMENTS IN THE SINAI NEAR THE SUEZ CANAL; THAT PIECE OF TERRITORY WAS NOT VITAL TO ISRAELI INTERESTS. THIS AFTERNOON TOP RANKING ISRAELI OFFICIALS AND THE SENIOR MEMBERS OF KISSINGER'S PARTY ARRIVED AT THE PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE TO BEGIN DETAILED DISCUSSIONS. THEY SAT IN WO ROWS FACING EACH OTHER. KISSINGER DIRECTLY ACROSS FROM GOLDA MEIR. THE TRAGEDY, ONE ISRAELI OFFICIAL TOLD ME, IS THAT THIS MAY LEAD TO A BLOW-UP BETWEEN AMERICA AND ISRAEL, AND OVER WHAT HE ASKED RHETORICALLY? SYRIA.

WHILE TALKS WERE UNDERWAY THIS AFTERNOON MRS. KISSINGER WAS TAKEN ON A WHIRLWIND ECUMENICAL TOUR OF JERUSALEM. FIRST AN OVERVIEW FROM THE MT. OF OLIVES, THEN A BRIEF STOP AT THE WAILING WALL WHERE ACCORDING TO ORTHODOX JEWISH TRADITION SHE WENT TO THE SECTION RESERVED FOR WOMEN, THE OMAR MOSQUE THE PLACE WHERE MOSLEMS BELIEVE THAT MOHAMMED ASCENDED TO HEAVEN, AND FINALLY THE CHURCH OF THE HOLY SEPULCHRE. THIS EVENING THE TALKS CONTINUED OVER DINNER AT THE HOME OF FOREIGN MINISTER ABBA EBAN. THESE DISCUSSIONS AS KISSINGER HIMSELF SAID LAST NIGHT IN EGYPT WILL BE VERY DIFFICULT."

C. KALB (CBS): "KISSINGER OPENED THIS ROUND OF SHUTTLE DIPLOMACY WITH A WARM HANDSHAKE FOR ISRAEL'S DOVISH FM EBAN. THEN THE SECRETARY CONFRONTED THE CENTRAL PROBLEM HERE -- A NATION IN ANXIETY EXPECTING HIM TO INDUCE ONE ISRAELI CONCESSION AFTER ANOTHER.

IN MIDAFTERNOON A TWO HOUR MEETING WITH ISRAEL'S TOP
POLITICAL AND MILITARY LEADERS. AN AIDE OF DAYAN
ARRIVED CARRYING A MAP OF THE GOLAN FRONT, THE BASIS
FOR THE REVIEW OF ALL ELEMENTS OF DISENGAGEMENT. ACCORDING
TO AN AMERICAN SPOKESMAN THESE INCLUDE: THE LINE TO BE
DRAWN, AN EXCHANGE OF PRISONERS, A DEFINITION OF A EUFFER
ZONE AND A ROLE FOR THE UN. KISSINGER EMERGED
CONCERNED ABOUT THE HEAVY FIGHTING ON THE GOLAN
FRONT. THE ISRAELIS CONSIDER THE FIGHTING A CONTRADICTION
OF THE SPIRIT OF NEGOTIATION. KISSINGER HOPES THAT BY THE
TIME HE LEAVES FOR SYRIA HE WILL HAVE WHAT HE LIKES TO
CALL A REFINEMENT IN THE ISRAELI POSITION, WHAT OTHERS
MIGHT CALL A MALIOR OPENING CONCESSION: NAMELY THAT ISRAEL

IS NOW READY TO RETREAT BEHIND THE 1967 CEASEFIRE LINE IF THAT IS THE PRICE FOR A DISENGAGEMENT AGREEMENT WITH ISRAEL."

2. RADIO: FOLLOWING KALB PIECE FROM JERUSALEM WAS CARRIED CBS-RADIO FRIDAY MORNING: "A CUP OF COFFEE IN THE KITCHEN, THAT IS THE UNOFFICIAL DESCRIPTION OF AN UNSCHEDULED MEETING WITH PM MEIR AND SECRETARY KISSINGER JUST HOURS BEFORE THE SECRETARY'S DEPARTURE FOR SYRIA. KISSINGER HAS ACCELERATED HIS TRAVEL SCHEDULE, IF THAT IS POSSIBLE, HE WILL RETURN TO ISRAEL TOMORROW EVENING AFTER A SIX HOUR STOP OVER IN EGYPT AFTER THE CONCLUSION OF HIS TALKS IN DAMASCUS. THIS STEP-UP SUGGESTS THAT ISRAEL MAY BE ON THE VERGE OF A MAJOR DECISION ABOUT DISENGAGEMENT AND KISSINGER WANTS TO MEET WITH ISRAELI

LEADERS AGAIN BEFORE THEIR CABINET MEETING SUNDAY MORNING. THEY ARE VERY WORRIED ABOUT THE HEAVY FIGHTING ON THE GOLAN FRONT AND THEY ARE URGING KISSINGER TO USE HIS INFLUENCE IN DAMASCUS, WHATEVER INFLUENCE HE MAY HAVE, TO LOWER THE LEVEL OF VIOLENCE AND TO WORK OUT A QUICK EXCHANGE OF WOUNDED AND OTHER PRISONERS OF WAR. IF THE SYRIANS INTENSIFY THE FIGHTING TO INCREASE PRESSURE ON ISRAEL TO MAKE CONCESSIONS, THAT STRATEGY MAY BACK-FIRE. THE ISRAELIS DO NOT FEEL THE FIGHTING IS THE PROPER BACK-GROUND MLSIC FOR PEACE TALKS." RUSH

SUMMARY: FRIDAY NEWSPAPER REPORTS VARY IN EMPHASIS. TIMES, POST AND GLOBE POINT TO ISRAELI RELUCTANCE TO COMPROMISE AND SUSPICION OF EGYPTIAN OPTIMISM. LATER REPORTS IN STAR AND ON AP AND UPI RELATE INCREASED OPTIMISM THAT "SHAPE OF AGREEMENT" IN VIEW. ALL EXPRESS CONCERN AT INCREASED FIGHTING ON GOLAN HEIGHTS. BOTH GLOBE AND MONITOR CARRY SEPARATE ARTICLES ON MRS. KISSINGER.

- 1. GWERTZMAN PAGE I ABOVE FOLD ARTICLE "KISSINGER MEETS ISRAELIS ON CRUCIAL SYRIAN TALKS" (PIX OF NEIR GREETING HAK AND MRS. KISSINGER) HAS HAK AVOIDING CONTENTIOUS ISSUES AND CONCENTRATING ON PRINCIPLES IN TALKS WITH ISRAELIS. REPORTS ISRAELIS HAVE TOLD HAK THEY WILL NOT BE RUSHED INTO ALTERING PROPOSALS AT THIS STAGE, ESPECIALLY IN LIGHT OF WORSENING MILITARY SITUATION ON GOLAN HEIGHTS. KISSINGER DESCRIBED BY ISRAELI OFFICIALS AS CONSCIOUS OF ISRAELI RELUCTANCE TO COMPROMISE WITHOUT CLEAR INDICATION OF SYRIAN VIEWS. GWERTZMAN NOTES SECURITY UNUSUALLY TIGHT DUE TO REPORTED PALESTINIAN THREATS ON SECRETARY'S LIFE.
- 2. BERGER HIGHLIGHTS ISRAELI MOOD OF RISING ANGER, TENSION AND SUSPICION IN PAGE 26 POST STORY "KISSINGER GREETED COOLLY IN ISRAEL" WITH SAME PIX OF NEIR, HAK, AND MRS. KISSINGER. QUOTES HAK ON ARRIVAL: "I CAME HERE NOT TO DISCUSS CONCESSIONS, EUT TO DISCUSS SECURITY". REPORTS HAK GREETED OUTSIDE HOTEL BY CHANTING DEMONSTRATORS WITH SIGNS READING "KISSINGER, WE ARE NOT FOR SALE". SAYS MOOD IN ISRAEL HAS SOURED DURING PAST WEEK. STATES ISRAELI SOURCES CONSIDER ARAB REPORTS THAT DISENGAGEMENT IS NEARLY WRAPPED UP A FORM OF PSYCHOLOGICAL PRESSURE TO REACH SETTLEMENT. CITES SENIOR OFFICIAL ON HAK PLANE WHO INSISTS THERE IS NO AGREEMENT YET, NOT 80 PERCENT, NOT 30 PERCENT, NOT 10 PERCENT.
- JHABVALA HAS TWO ARTICLES: PAGE 2 REPORT OF JERUSALEM STOP "KISSINGER, ISRAELIS CONFER", AND PAGE 1 REPORTER'S NOTEBOOK "ON THE ROAD WITH THE KISSINGERS", WITH PIX OF HAK AND MRS. KISSINGER AT MICROPHONES AND OF MEIR GREETING COUPLE AT HER RESIDENCE. SUBSTANTIVE

PIECE REPORTS ISRAELI RELUCTANCE TO BEND AND SUSPICION THAT EGYPTIAN OPTIMISM ACTUALLY A FORM OF PRESSURE ON ISRAELIS. HAS MCCLOSKEY REFERRING TO TALKS WITH ISRAELIS AS "CHARACTERISTICALLY FRIENDLY". "NOTEBOOK" ARTICLE CONSISTS OF VIGNETTES FROM TRIP. EMPHASIS ON MRS. KISSINGER BRINGING "WARMTH AND MATRONLY CHEER" TO SHUTTLE DIPLOMACY.

- SAIKOWSKI OF CSM HAS TWO ARTICLES AS WELL, BOTH PAGE 1. ONE A REPORT FROM JERUSALEM "KISSINGER BUILDS MOOD, THEN HARD-BARGAINS", THE OTHER A PIECE ON MRS. KISSINGER "NANCY K .: DIPLOMACY AND MATCHING TOENAILS". FIRST ARTICLE STATES PRELIMINARIES AND MOOD-BUILDING ARE OVER. CONTRASTS EGYPTIAN OPTIMISM WITH US CAUTION, HAS HIGH US OFFICIAL WITH HAK PARTY REFERRING TO REPORT THAT AGREEMENT 80 PERCENT COMPLETED AS "TOTALLY WRONG". SAME OFFICIAL SAYS THREE MAIN ISSUES UNRESOLVED: LOCATION OF DISENGAGEMENT LINE, DISPOSITION OF FORCES ON LINE, AND MEANS OF SEPARATING FORCES. US OFFICIALS CAUTION AGAINST VIEWING CURRENT TALKS WITH ISRAELIS AS "MAKE OR BREAK" HIGH US OFFICIAL SAYS HAK NOW KNOWS "FRAMEWORK OF THE NEGOTIATIONS". ARTICLE ON MRS. KISSINGER HAS QUOTE ON HAK FROM EGYPTIAN OFFICIAL: "THIS MAN CAN RUN FOR ELECTIONS IN THIS COUNTRY ANY TIME HE GETS FIRED.
- 5. O'LEARY ARTICLE IN AFTERNOON STAR PAGE 4 REPORTS MCCLOSKEY FRIDAY MORNING NEWS CONFERENCE IN JERUSALEM UNDER HEAD "KISSINGER INTENSIFIES MEDIATION" WITH PIX OF MRS. KISSINGER AND MRS. EBAN AT WAILING WALL. MCCLOSKEY ANNOUNCES CHANGE IN SCHEDULE, SAYS IT REPRESENTS

INTENSIFICATION OF DISCUSSIONS, CHARACTERIZES DEVELOPMENT AS "NOT DISCOURAGING". US OFFICIALS SAY CEASEFIRE AN ELEMENT OF DISENGAGEMENT PROCESS, NOT PRECONDITION FOR AGREEMENT. O'LEARY REPORTS TONE OF US ANNOUNCEMENT MEANS HAK MAKING PROGRESS WITH ISRAELIS AND RETURNING TO ISRAEL SOONER THAN EXPECTED TO KEEP MOMENTUM GOING.

6. BARRY SCHWEID LEAD ON AP HAS SENIOR US OFFICIAL STATING THAT "THE SHAPE OF AN AGREEMENT" HAS BECOME APPARENT AND THAT ISRAELIS HAVE BEGUN TO NEGOTIATE FOR THE ATTAINABLE INSTEAD OF THE IDEAL. KISSINGER--"NOT AT ALL AS LONG AS AFTER EACH TRIP I CAN SEE RELATIONS IMPROVE BETWEEN THE AMERICANS AND THE ARABS."

7. WILBUR LANDRY OF UPI, A SHADE LESS OPTIMISTIC THAN AP, REFERS TO US OFFICIALS' COMMENT THAT SHAPE OF AGREEMENT IN SIGHT, BUT AGREEMENT NOT CERTAIN ON THIS TRIP. HAS SAME OFFICIAL WARNING CURRENT NEGOTIATION DIFFICULT SINCE LESS ROOM FOR MANEUVER ON GOLAN HEIGHTS. OFFICIAL SAYS TALKS IN ISRAEL WENT AS EXPECTED. LANDRY QUOTES HAK FROM DAMASCUS ARRIVAL EXCHANGE WITH KHADDAM TO EFFECT THAT FIRST STEP TOWARD DISENGAGEMENT DIFFICULT FOR SYRIA AFTER GENERATION OF MISTRUST, BUT "I BELIEVE THE POSSIBILITIES EXIST FOR TAKING THE FIRST STEP". HOWEVER, HIGH AMERICAN OFFICIAL ABOARD KISSINGER PLANE SAYS SYRIAN DEMAND FOR ISRAELI WITHDRAWAL ON GOLAN HEIGHTS MUST BE SCALED TO HAVE AN AGREEMENT.
