THE TELEGRAM STATES: KISSINGER AND I WILL NOT MEET EITHER IN HONG KONG OR IN CHINA. PRINCE SIHANOUK SENT A COPY OF THE TELEGRAM TO THIS AFP CORRESPONDENT ON TUESDAY.

THE HEAD OF THE ROYAL GOVERNMENT OF THE NATIONAL UNION OF CAMBODIA (RGNUC) ADDED: THE U.S. GOVERNMENT REFUSES TO HOLD ANY MEETING WITH ME OR ANY TALKS WITH MY GOVERNMENT. UNDER THESE CONDITIONS, THE WAR IN CAMBODIA WILL CONTINUE.

THE TELEGRAM WAS SENT FROM HAIKOW IN THE PROVINCE OF KWANGTUNG (THE PROVINCIAL CAPITAL IS CANTON) WHERE THE PRINCE IS MAKING AN OFFICIAL VISIT FOLLOWING HIS RETURN FROM HANOI LAST WEEK.
