INCOME LEVELS...SMITH COMMENTARY STRONGLY URGED END TO SUBSIDIES AND CROPLINITATIONS AS WAY TO SOLVE BOTH DOMESTIC AND INTERNATIONAL ECONOMIC PROBLEMS OF US.

ALL NETS W/134 MINUTES OF VERY NEGATIVE, DUTSPOKEN REACTION ACROSS US AS PEOPLE INTERVIEWED AT MARKETS CALLED FOOD PRICE JUMP "DISGRACE, MISERABLE, AND RIDICULOUS" AND PREDICTED THEY'D HAVE TO STOP BUYING MEAT. AND NBC REPORT ON ALTERNATIVES TO MEAT SUGGESTED BY ADMINATIVE AND NBC CHICKEN WHICH WH DRAMITIZED AT PN'S BIRTHDAY DINNER—FOUND THEY ARE -NO BARGAIN" EITHER...NBC DID FIND A "SMALL COMFORT" IN ECONOMIC NEWS, REPORTING TRADE DEFICIT WAS A "LITTLE LESS IN THE RED" IN '72 THAN HAD BEEN EXPECTED. GOOD FILM ON ABC/NBC (CONCLUDED LATTER SHOW) AS RN TOLD VISITING SOVIET WOMEN GYMNASTS HE HAD WATCHED THE DLYMPICS ON TV AND NOTICED THEIR ABILITY TO LAND ON THEIR FEET--SOMETHING WASH, POLITICIANS ALSO TRY TO DO BUT NOT AS SUCCESSFULLY. COURTEOUS LAUGHTER AFTER TRANS-LATION, SAID JARRIEL. RN ALSO ON FILM ON BOTH NETS SAYING "WHATEVER THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE LEADERS OF THE WORLD, WE THINK THE YOUNG PEDPLE CAN LIVE W/MIR Y DRUZHBA (PEACE AND FRIENDSHIP)."
