VORUNTSOV CALLED WITH AN DRAL NOTE FROM BREZHNEV TO THE PRESIDENT CONCERNING SOVIET PARTICIPATION IN MEETINGS TO DEAL WITH THE ENERGY PROBLEM. THE NOTE READS AS FOLLOWS: "LEONID BREZHNEY ASKS TO CONVEY TO THE PRESIDENT HIS GRATITUTDE FOR A CONSTRUCTIVE AND QUICK REPLY OF THE AMERICAN SIDE TO HIS (BREZHNEV'S) CONSIDERATIONS CONCERNING THE INITIATIVE OF THE PRESIDENT IN CALLING CERTAIN MEETINGS ON THE OIL PROBLEM. WE TAKE NOTE OF WHAT THE SECRETARY SAID CONCERNING THE POSSI-BILITY OF SOVIET UNION PARTICIPATION AS -- IN OBSERVER STATUS IN THE WORK OF THE CONFERENCE, THAT IS, THE CONFERENCE JOINTLY OF CONSUMERS AND PRODUCING COUNTRIES OF OIL. SO FAR AS THE BILATERAL CONSULTATIONS OR EXCHANGE OF OPINIONS BETWEEN THE SOVIET UNION AND THE UNITED STATES ON THE DIL PROBLEM. WE ARE IN AGREEMENT WITH DR. KISSINGER'S SUGGESTIONS TO HAVE TO THAT EFFECT AN EXCHANGE OF OPINION IN WASHINGTON AND WOULD PROPOSE TO START IT ON FEBRUARY 28TH. THE SOVIET REPRESENTATIVE AT THOSE NEGOTIATIONS OR EXCHANGE OF OPINIONS WILL BE MR. OSIPHY. THE DEPUTY MINISTER FOR FOREIGN TRADE. WE WOULD LIKE TO KNOW THE OPINION OF THE WHITE HOUSE WHETHER THIS DATE IS ACCEPTABLE TO THE AMERICAN SIDE FOR THE BEGINNING OF THIS EXCHANGE OF OPINIONS,"
