THE WASHINGTON POSTI CARROLL"KILPATRICK-REPORTS ON ANOTHER ENORMOUS EGYPTIAN WEL-COME GIVEN THE PRESIDENT AS HE TRAVELED BY TRAIN FROM CAIRD TO ALEXANDRIA. HE NOTES THE PRESIDENT'S PLEDGE OF AMERICAN SSPPORT IN DEVELOPING A FORMULA FOR A MIDDLE EAST SETTLEMENT BEFORE THE RECFENING OF THE GENEVA PEACE CONFERENCE. THE FRONT PAGE CARRIES A PHOTO OF THE PRESIDENT ON THE TRAIN BEING CHEERED BY A LARGE NUMBER OF EGYPTIANS. JIM HOAGLAND WRITES THAT THE WELCOME GIVEN THE PRESIDENT WAS HE CITES AN INSTANCE WHERE A MAN SHOUTED TO THE PEOPLE PLANNED. THAT THEY MUST GIVE A GOOD WELCOME TO THE PRESIDENT. BUT THE APPRECIATION OF THE MIDDLE EAST PEACE EFFORTS BY PRESIDENT NIXON AND YOU HAVE PLAYED AN EVEN GREATER ROLE IN SHAPING A GENUINELY ENTHUSIASTIC WELCOME FOR A LEADER WHO ONE YEAR AGO WAS BEING STRONGLY DENGUNCED IN EGYPT. MEVERYTHING RELEVANT TO ANYTHING ANYBODY HAS SAID ON YOUR CON-NECTION IN THE WIRETAPPING, WATERGATE, ETC." (1) MARILYN BERGER COVERS THE ABC SPECIAL OF YOUR INTERVIEW TAPED LAST SATURDAY TO BE AIRED TONIGHT. SHE STARTS OFF WITH YOUR STATEMENT THAT YOU WOULD RESIGN IF YOU FELT HOREIGN POLICY WAS BEING MANIPULATED FOR DOMESTIC POLITICAL PURPOSES. (10) JOE ALSOP PUTS THE BLAME ON THE MEDIA POR YOUR DECISION TO HE SAYS MIT IS HYPROCRISY TO PRETEND RESIGN UNLESS CLEARED. THE PRESS WAS NOT RESPONSIBLE. " YOUR RECEPTION, AFTER ONE OF THE GREATEST AND MOST TOTALLY EXHAUSTING DIPLOMATIC, FEATS IN MORE THAN A CENTURY, WAS A SAVAGE AND DISGUSTING PRESS CONFERENCE DURING WHICH YOU WERE TREATED LIKE A COMMON CRIMINAL. THE CLIMAX, ALSOP SAYS, WAS THE NEW YORK TIMES EDITORIAL ACCUSING YOU OF "DISSEMBLING" IN TONES MAJESTICALLY COMBINING SELF-RIGHTEOUSNESS AND PECKSNIFFERY. ALSOP SAYS HE HAS SEEN NO ACCOUNT OF YOUR THREAT TO RESIGN THAT HAS SET FORTH THE FACTS EITHER FULLY OR FORTHRIGHTLY. JAMES RESTON ENTITLES HIS COLUMN "THE ART AND STYLE OF RESIGNING." RESTON SAYS THAT "THE PEOPLE WHO SHOULD RESIGN WON'T, AND THE PEOPLE WHO SHOULDN'T THREATEN TO DO SO.\* IN YOUR CASE, YOU SOMEHOW MISPLACED TWO OF YOUR MOST CELEBRATED QUALITIES -- A SENSE OF HUMOR AND YOUR GIFT OF LOGIC. HE SEES YOUR MAER-FORMANCEM, LIKE AN ACTOR WHO THREATENS TO QUIT THE THEATER BE-RESTON ASKS WHAT YOU CAUSE HE GOT A COUPLE OF BUM REVIEWS. THINK PRESIDENT NIXON SHOULD DO FACING MUCH MORE SERIOUS AND PROLONG CHARGES ABOUT HIS CREDIBILITY. HE GOES ON TO APPLAUD YOUR INTELLIGENCE, PERSONALITY AND CHARACTER AND HOW YOU HAVE CHANGED U.S. FOREIGN RELATIONS. CONCLUSIVELY, RESTON ASSERTS THAT THE HEAVY DIVISIONS IN THE COUNTRY THAT YOU SPEAK OF; IS NOT LIKELY TO BE OBTAINED BY RESIGNING AT THE WRONG TIME AND ON THE WRONG ISSUUE. THE BALTIMORE SUN SADAT AND NIXON AGREED ON A "STEP-BY-STEP APPROACH" TO TRY TO REACH A MIDDLE FAST PEACE "NOT BECAUSE WE WANT TO GO SLOW BUT BECAUSE WE WANT TO GET THERE ." (A-1)MENA REPORTS ON THE NORTH YEMEN COUP RESULTING FROM A THREAT BY PRESIDENT IRYANI TO RESIGN. (A-2) A MULTI-NATION TASK FORCE SET UP TO OVERHAUL THE WORLD MONETARY SYSTEM ENDED 14 MONTHS OF NEGOTIATIONS BY ADDPTING A SERIES OF "INTERIM" MEASURES DESIGNED TO CONTINUE THE PRESENT MAKESHIFT SYSTEM OF FEDATING RATES. (A-4) THREE LEBANESE VILLAGES ON THE EASTERN SLOPES OF MOUNT HERMON CAME UNDER ISRAELT SHELLING AND THE FIRE WAS RETURNED BY THE LEBANESE ARMY.
PODGORNY DUTLINED SOME OF THE PROBLEMS THAT MOSCON FEELS STAND IN THE WAY OF IMPROVED EAST-WEST RELATIONS. HE SPECIFICALLY DE-NOUNCED EFFORTS BY WESTERN COUNTRIES TO WIN POLITICAL LIBERALIZA-TION IN THE SOVIET UNION AND IN EASTERN EUROPE AS THE PRICE OF THE EUROPEAN SECURITY CONFERENCE. (A-6) AN EDITORIAL ADMONISHES EFFORTS TO SOLVE THE "KISSINGER CASE" VIA IRRESPONSIBLE EMOTIONALISM, I.E., A RESOLUTION PRAISING YOU AS A PATRIOTIC AMERICAN "WHOSE INTEGRITY AND VERACITY ARE ABOVE REPROACH." THE SUN SEES THE ISSUE AS WHETHER OR NOT YOU DIS-SEMBLED IN TESTIMONY BEFORE A SENATE COMMITTEE, AND THE ANSWER CAN ONLY COME COOLLY AND FACTUALLY. (A-16) A SECOND EDITORIAL NOTES THAT THE TALKS BETWEEN KREISKY AND NIXON HAVE BEEN "LOST-IN-THE-SHUFFLE" -- YOUR RESIGNATION THREAT" AND GENERAL PREDCCUPATION WITH THE MIDDLE EAST TRIP. THE SUN RHETORICALLY PONDERS WHETHER KRIESKY MADE IT CLEAR TO THE PRESI-DENT THAT MANY WESTERN EUROPEANS ARE RESISTING A SECURITY CON-FERFNCE SUMMIT UNTIL IT MEANS SOMETHING.
