THE WASHINGTON POST
THE POST HEADLINES THE NUCLEAR AGREEMENT AND DEVOTES A CONSIDERABLE AMOUNT OF THE FRONT PAGE TO THE MIDDLE EAST, INCLUDING A LARGE PICTURE OF THE PRESIDENT WITH PRESIDENT SADAT
AND ONE OF THE PRESIDENT WITH KING FAISAL. JIM HOAGLAND WRITES
THE NUCLEAR COMMITMENT WAS THE MOST SPECIFIC PLEDGE UNDERTAKEN
