THE NEW YORK TIMES

THE KREMLINIS EFFORTS TO PROMOTE SOVIET PRESTIGE THROUGH A SUC-CESSION OF FORUMS ABROAD APPEAR TO HAVE BEEN STALLED DESPITE SOME ADVANTAGES OFFERED BY RECENT AMERICAN SETBACKS. THE SITUATION, IN WHICH MOSCOW IS BEING FRUSTRATED BY A TIMETABLE OF ITS OWN OPTIMISTIC MAKING, FIGURES IN SOVIET CONCERN AT A TIME WHEN GROMYKO IS BELIEVED TO BE RAISING SOME OF THE MORE PRESSING PROBLEMS WITH YOU AT YOUR TWO-DAY MEETING IN VIENNA.

THE IMPLICATION IS THAT THINGS ARE STILL NOT SETTLED, THAT WITHIN CHINA THERE IS INSTABILITY. AND THAT ITS EXTERNAL POLICIES MUST BE WATCHED WARTLY. SHARP DEPATE HAS ALWAYS BEEN PRESENT WITHIN THE COMMUNIST PARTY, AND THERE WILL BE SUCH CONFLICTS IN THE FUTURE. BUT THERE IS NO OUFSTION THAT THE MEW CONSTITUTION AND MR. ACCORDING TO A REPORT PREPARED FOR DELIVERY AT THE 240-MAN ARMED FORCES ASSEMBLY THAT BEGAN YESTERDAY MORNING, THE ARMY WAS PREPARED TO DISCOUNT THE RESULTS OF THE APRIL 25 FLECTIONS. A THREAT RUNNING THROUGH ANOTHER REPORT WAS A FRANK DISENCHANTMENT WITH PARTY RIVALRIES AND A CLEAR DESIRE FOR THE ARMY TO RUN THE COUNTRY ALONE. THERE WAS AN EXPECTATION BY SOME MILITARY SOURCES THAT THE ASSEMBLY MOULD OUST PRESIDENT COSTA GOMES OR SO WEAKEN HIS POSITION BY DISMISSING HIS SUPPORTERS THAT HE COULD NOT CONTINUE LONG IN THE PRESIDENTIAL PALACE. IN ITS LEAD EDITORTAL. THE SUN CONTENDS THAT DRVIOUSLY A MAYAGUEZ POST-MORTEM HTLE HAVE ITS MILITARY USES IN PINPOINT-ING FLANS IN INTELLIGENCE OPERATIONS AND THE DEPLOYMENT OF FORCES. " BUT WHAT CONGRESS MUST CONSIDER CAREFULLY IS WHETHER THE ONLY LASTING ALTERNATIVE IS THE QUINTESSENTTAL PENTAGON STRATEGY ENUNCIATED BY MR. BCHLESTNOER . IF THE NATION IS TO HAVE A "GREAT DEBATE" ON FOREIGN POLICY AND SECURITY THAT MEANS SOMETHING, ITS LEGISLA-TORS SHOULD SEE WHETHER OTHER ALTERNATIVES ARE AVAILABLE THAT HOULD PROVIDE MORE HOPE OF A PEACEFUL WORLD.
