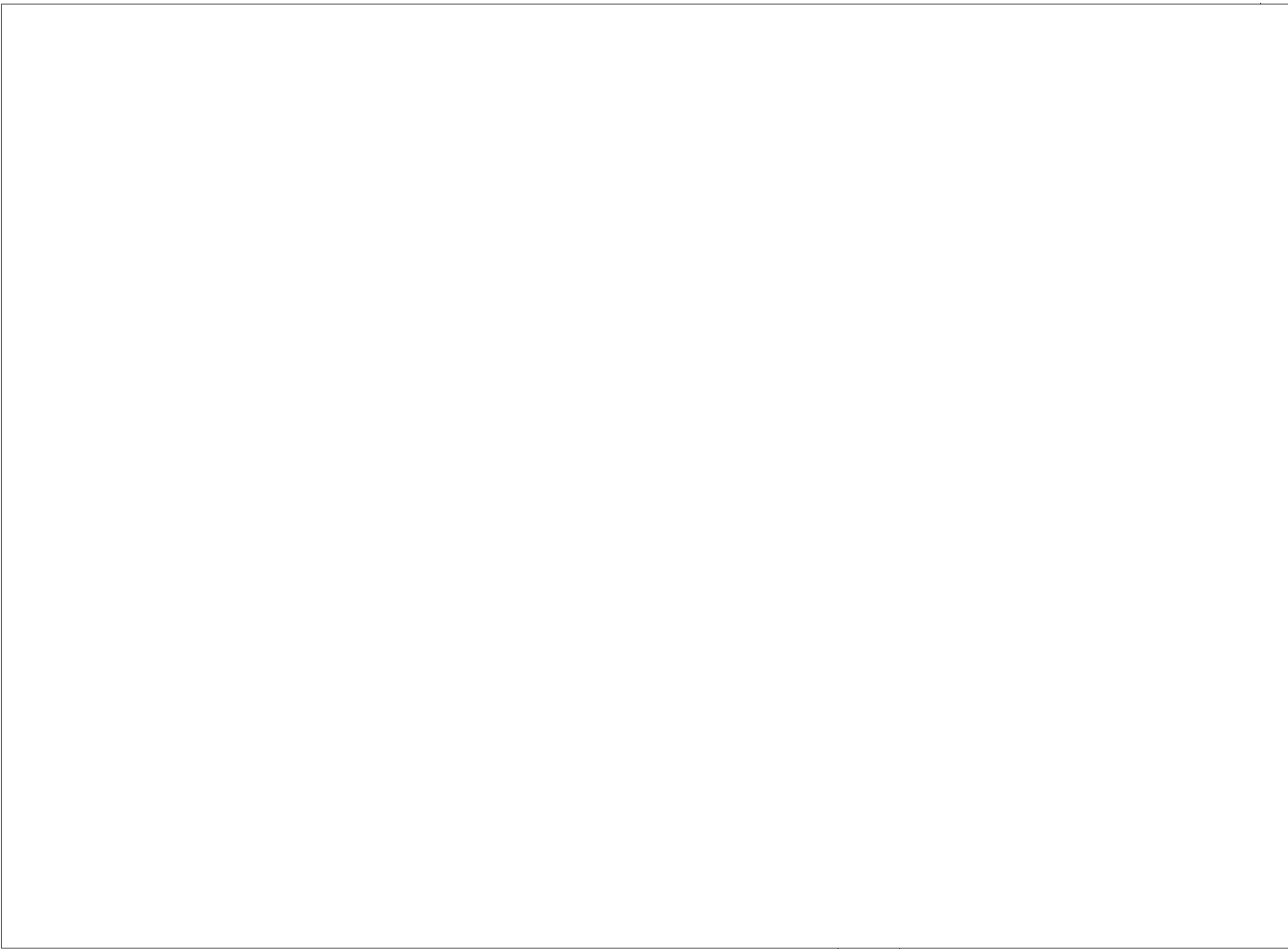

You will recall that when the Vice President stopped briefly in the Philippines, President Marcos gave him a file of documents which alleged that several Americans were involved in plotting his assassination. At your direction, 25X1 CIA has completed its analysis of the documents. Director Schlesinger's conclusions are as follows:

The file of documents which President Marcos gave the Vice President on the alleged plot against his life has been evaluated by the CIA and the evaluation sent to the President. The President asked that the report which is at Tab A be passed to the Vice President.

The documents are now with the FBI for investigation of the domestic aspects of the case. I will inform you of the results of that investigation.

At Tab B is a sample message to President Marcos, in the event that you might wish to keep him abreast of developments.
