- I. I HAVE INFORMED THIEU, KY, AND GOTTEN WORD TO GENERAL MINH SUBSTANCE OF YOUR 93049. I HAVE NOT YET GOTTEN THE WORD TO DON. THIEU EXPRESSED APPRECIATION OF PRESIDENT'S AND U.S. GOVERNMENT'S ATTITUDE TOWARD POLITICAL ACTIVITY OF DON AND MINH, BUT SAID THAT NEITHER HAD THE SUPPORT NOR CAPABILITY TO STAGE A COUP. IF WE FELT IT NECESSARY TO GET THE MESSAGE TO THEM HE SUGGESTED IT BE DONE "INDIRECTLY" AND IN A MANNER WHICH WOULD NOT LEAD THEM TO BELIEVE THAT WE ATTACHED MUCH IMPORTANCE TO THEIR ACTIVITIES: IN FACT, THIEU HAS COME INCREASINGLY TO FEEL THAT BOTH DON'S AND MINH'S GAMBITS HAVE PRETTY WELL PETERED OUT. MINH HAS, IN FACT, THREE TIMES RECENTLY PUBLICLY BACKED AWAY FROM HIS PROPOSALS FOR A REFERENDUM OR "CONSULTATION OF THE PEOPLE" AND HAS EXPRESSED HIS SUPPORT AND FRIENDSHIP FOR THIEU.
- 2. I HAVE APPROACHED THIS PROBLEM CAUTIOUSLY, FOR I DO NOT WANT TO LET EITHER DON OR MINH BE ABLE TO GOVE THE IMPRESSION THAT WE ATTACH UNDUE IMPORTANCE TO THEIR INFLUENCE OR ARE FEARFUL OF IT NOR DO I WANT TO START RUMORS IN THE SAIGON TEA HOUSES.
  - 3. I HOPE TO GET THE WORD TO DON WITHIN THE NEXT FEW DAYS.
