On April 6 we informed John Guthrie, in reply to his request that you attend a Bonds for Israel Dinner being given at the Washington Hilton Hotel on May 10 honoring Teamsters' President Frank E. Fitzsimmons, that you do not normally attend these affairs (Tab C). Nevertheless, Mr. Guthrie followed up on April 9 with a memorandum stating "We'd like to see Dr. Kissinger represent the President, if possible" at the dinner (Tab B).

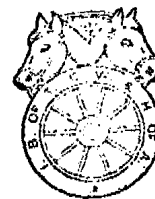
