1ST ADD 1ST NIGHT LD 327A KOREA SEOUL XXX SPOKESMAN SAID PREMIER KIM JONG-PIL AND ALL OTHER CABINET MEMBERS RESIGNED AFTER AN EMERGENCY CABINET MEETING, ACCORDING TO CULTURE-INFORMATION MINISTER YOON CHU-YOUNG, SPEAKING FOR THE ADMINISTRATION.

ALMOST AT THE SAME TIME, ALL KEY MEMBERS OF THE PRESIDENTIAL STAFF, INCLUDING THE CHIEF SECRETARY AND PARK'S SECURITY CHIEF, SUBMITTED THEIR RESIGNATIONS, A PRESIDENTIAL OFFICE SPOKESMAN SAID.

THE MOVES CAME ONE DAY AFTER THE NATION BURIED MRS. PARK CHUNG-HEE, SLAIN THURSDAY BY A GUNMAN'S BULLET INTENDED FOR HER HUSBAND.
