AGOSTINHO NETO, PRESIDENT OF MPLA, JOACQUIM PINTO DE ANDRADE, LEADER OF "EASTERN ACTIVE REVOLT," AND DANIEL CHIPENDA, LEADER OF "EASTERNREVOLT," SIGNED ON BEHALF OF THREE FACTIONS.

RESIDENT OF MPLA, ASSISTED BY THO VICE PRESIDENTS AND ADE AND CHIPENDA. NEW LEADERSHIP STRUCTURE WILL TNOLUDE MPLA GENTRAL COMMITTEE COMPRISED OF 39 MEMBERS. SIXTEEN WILL COME FROM NETO FACTION, 13 PROM "EASTERN REVOLT" GROUP, AND 10 FROM "EASTERN ACTIVE REVOLT" CAMP. THERE WILL BE NINE MEMBER POLITICAL BUREAU, WITH EACH GROUP HAVING THREE REPRESENTATIVES IN ADDITION TO PRESIDENT AND TWO VICE PRESIDENTS OF MPLA, COMMUNIQUE STATEO 1 HNEW MPLA DIRECTION THUS CONSTITUTED MAKES CALL TO ALL ITS MILITANTS AND TO ANGULAN PEOPLE TO RENOUBLE THEIR VIGILANCE IN ORDER THAT UNITY MAY BE PRESERVED AND REINFORCE FOR INTENSIFYING STRUGGLE VIS A-VIS COMMON ENEMY UNTIL FINAL VICTORY."
