SUMMARY: PRINCIPAL OPPOSITION PARTY (COPEI) HAS SHARPLY CRI-TICIZED GOVIS HANDLING OF DAS MEETING, PARTICULARLY APPARENT FAILUR OF FOREIGN MINISTER SHCACHT TO ENSURE FAVORABLE RESULTS BEFORE SPUNSORING SUCH A MEETING. COMMENTS FROM MOST OTHER PARTIES HAVE ALSO BEEN CRITICAL OF GOV AND OF U.S. END SUMMARY.

ON NOVEMBER 13COPET LEADERSHIP ISSUED A COMMUNIQUE CRITICIZING THE GOV'S HANDLING OF DAS MEETING. COMMUNIQUE CHASTIZED FOREIGN MINISTERS ON CUBAN SANCTIONS WITHOUT MEETING OF DAS FOREIGN MINISTERS ON CUBAN SANCTIONS WITHOUT ENSUREING IN ADVANCE THAT THE RESULTS OF THE MEETING WOLD BE FAVORABLE. COMMUNIQUE STATED THAT "TO SUPPORT A MEETING WITHOUT THIS GURANTEE IS IRRESPONSIBLY TO EXPOSE THE COUNTRY TO THE DISHONOR OF A DEFEAT AND THE SUBSEQUENT REDUCTIO OF ITS INTERNATIONAL PRESTIGE."

DOCUMENT ALSO CRITICIZED PEREZ GOY "NMENT FOR "MANIFEST TACTLESSNESS AND EVIDENT INDISCRE" ON, " PARTICULARLY FOR PROPOSING MAJOR REPORS IN THE INTERAMERICAN SYSTEM SWIHTOUT A CLEAR TOPA OF WHAT THE OUTCOME OF THE DUITO MEETING WOULD BE.



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- POSITION ON THE QUITO CUNFERENCE, COPEI PRESIDENT GODOFREDO GONZALEZ AND ARISTICES CALVANI, FOREIGN MINISTER IN FORMER GOVERNMENT, ACCUSED GOV OF "MAKING A PROCEDURAL ERROR." IN NOT ENSURING BEFOREHAND THAT MEETING WOULD BE A SUCCESS. CALVANI COMMENTED THAT THERE HAS BEEN A "PROFOUND CHANGE" IN INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS IN RECENT YEARS AND THAT THE DAS ITSELF HAD ENDORSED THE IDEA OF TOLERATING IDEOLOGICAL PLURALITY AMONG ALL THE LATIN AMERICAN NATIONS. HE CONTINUED, HOWEVER, THAT CUPEI HAD NOT BELIEVED THAT THE CUBA QUSTION WAS IMPORTANT ENOUGH TO CALL FOR A SPECIAL MEETING OF DAS FOREIGN MINISTERS.
- S. SURVEY BY "EL NACIONAL" OF REACTIONS BY VARIOUS POLITICAL
  LEADERS REFLECTED STRONG CRITICISM OF BOTH GOV AND U.S.
  POSITIONS. PEDRO PARLS MONTESINOS, POLITICAL SECRETARY
  OF PRESIDENT PEREZ'S ACCION DEMOCRATICA PARTY, SAID THAT THE
  UPTIMISM OF CULOMBIA, COSTA RICA, AND VENEZUELA HAD BEEN
  UNJUSTIFIED AND LACKED CAMEFUL PRIOR EXAMINIATION OF THE
  SITUATION. AT THE SAME TIME, HE WARNED THAT POLITICAL ANDMILITARY INTERVENTION BY THE U.S. IN GUATEMALA IN 1954 AND IN
  THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC IN 1965 AND THE U.S. IS CONSTANT REFUSAL
  TO GIVE REAL SUBSTANCE TO THE NOTION OF CONTINENTAL ECONOMIC
  SOLIDARITY GALLED FOR A REVISION OF THE INTER-AMERICAN TREARY
  OF RECIPROCAL ASSISTANCE. PARIS ADDED THAT THERE WERE
  NEITHER JURIDICAL NOR PRACTICAL RESTACLES PREVENTING VENEZUELA
  FROM UNILATERALLY ESTABLISHING RELATIONS MITH CUBA.
- A. SENATOR PONPEYO MARGUEZ OF FAR-LEFT MAS PARTY STATED THAT THE U.S. DECISION TO APSTAIN AND THE ABSENCE OF SECRETARY KISSINGER DEMOSTRATED THE USELESSNESS OF THE QAS. URO SPOKESMAN BRITO VILLARRUEL FAVORED RESUMPTION OF REALTIONS WITH CUBA, HHILL INDEPENDENT HERMOGENES LOPEZ COUNSELLED AGAINST CLOSE RELATIONS WITH DICTATORSHIPS INCLUDING THAT OF CASTRU. MEP PRESIDENT PRIETO FIGUENDA SAID THAT THE COUNTRIES WHICH HAD ABSTAINED FROM VOTING DEMONSTRATED THEIR USERVILITY TO I HE U.S. WATIONAL CIVIC CRUSADE (PRO-PEREZ JIMENEZ) SENATOR HURTADO DIAZ CLAIMED THAT WANARCHY NOW REIGNED IN THE OAS.
