Reply to Eilts Message on NAMRU

The subject of Ambassador Eilts'message at Tab B is the Naval Medical Research Unit (NAMRU). It is one of those US institutions in Egypt that survived the break in diplomatic relations in 1967. The purpose of NAMRU is to conduct research on tropical diseases, a function it has performed effectively since World War II. It has a sizable American staff and is located on the outskirts of Cairo. NAMRU has normally had cordial relations with the Egyptian Ministry of Health.

Ambassador Eilts' message does not require a substantive reply, but we have attached at Tab A a brief acknowledgement that the Secretary or you could send to Eilts.

RECOMMENDATION: That you seek the Secretary's approval to send the message at Tab A.

- 1. FOR PAST TWO MONTHS WE HAVE BEEN PRESSED BY CULTURAL SECTION OF FOREIGN MINISTRY TO BEGIN NEGOTIATIONS FOR A NEW NAMRU POLICY AGREEMENT. IT APPEARS THAT WHEN NAMRU LEASE WAS RENEWED LAST JULY, MINISTER OF HEALTH SOUGHT TO INSIST ON INCLUSION OF SEVERAL OPERATIONAL MATTERS WHICH WOULD IN EFFECT HAVE GIVEN EGYPTIANS COEQUAL STATUS IN NAMRU. NAMRU CHIEF OBJECTED AND MANAGED TO GET THESE PROVISIONS KEPT OUT OF THE LEASE, BUT MINISTER OF HEALTH THEN ASKED FOREIGN MINISTRY TO HANDLE MATTER ON A MORE FORMAL GOVERNMENT-TO-GOVERNMENT LEVEL.
- I HAVE DELIBERATELY DELAYED GIVING MY ANSWER TO THE CULTURAL SECTION SINCE I KNOW US NAVY FEELS STRONGLY ABOUT NOT GETTING EGYPTIANS ANY MORE INTO THE NAMRU ACT. WHEN WITH FAHMY TODAY, I TOLD HIM ABOUT THE PROBLEM AND SUGGESTED ON A PURELY PERSONAL BASIS THAT HE SHOULD FOR THE TIME BEING GET THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND HIS CULTURAL SECTION TO DROP THE SUBJECT. GIVEN WHAT I UNDERSTAND ARE ZUMWALT'S NEGATIVE VIEWS ON SUEZ CANAL REOPENING AND OTHER MATTERS OF INTEREST TO EGYPT AND THE JOB OF CONDITIONING IT WILL TAKE WITH HIM AND SOME OF THE OTHER ADMIRALS, I POINTED OUT THAT IT IS IN NEITHER OF OUR INTERESTS OF MUDDY THE WATERS BY PRESSING NOW ON WHAT IS BASICALLY A MINOR ISSUE, BUT ONE WHICH COULD GET NAVY BACKS UP.
- 3. FAHMY KNEW NOTHING ABOUT THE CULTURAL SECTION'S APPROACHES.

 HE IMMEDIATELY AGREED AND UNDERTOOK TO GET IN TOUCH WITH THE MINISTER

 OF HEALTH TO ASK HIM TO LAY OFF. HE SAID HE WILL ALSO ARRANGE THAT I

 CALL ON THE MINISTER TO DISCUSS NAMRU OPERATION, WHICH I SAID I WOULD

 OF COURSE BE PLEASED TO DO. AS FOR HIS CULTURAL SECTION, HE TOLD ME

 SIMPLY TO IGNORE ITS APPROACHES ON THE SUBJECT.
- 4. HOWEVER, SINCE WE MUST WORK WITH CULTURAL SECTION ON OTHER MATTERS, I SUBSEQUENTLY ASKED SIRRI TO LET HIS CULTURAL COLLEAGUES KNOW THE MINISTER DOES NOT WANT THE NAMRU ISSUE PUSHED. BT 350
