**Wayne:**

I believe it would be preferable if you would delete the following sentence from the draft proposed memorandum to Director Helms:

"Some redirection of its goals may be useful and a representative of my staff will be in touch with Bruce Clarke on this matter."

It would be better either not to refer to a redirection of goals in the memorandum and simply do this informally or state in the memorandum the specific goals we have in mind, using language such as:

"In resuming this study it may be useful to consider the following  
. . . ."
