**MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD**

General Walters called on October 15 and stated that he had been called at midnight by the PRC Ambassador in Paris and was asked to visit the Ambassador today. He did so and was given the following message:

(1) The People's Republic agrees to an engineer-communicator and establishment of direct communications with Washington, D. C. The link will be activated at two-hour intervals from the aircraft on even days or as directed.

(2) The People's Republic of China would like to know the power frequency, call sign, and method of operation of this link before October 18.
