SALT

-- we propose an equal aggregate of 2,350 ICBMs, SLEMs and heavy bombers.

-- That SLBMs and heavy bombers may be substituted for ICBMs and for each other.

-- That there be no construction of additional fixed land-based ICBM launchers.

-- That within this context we would be prepared to consider banning:

- Cruise missiles of intercontinental range.
- Strategic missiles on waterborne missiles other than submarines.
- Air-to-surface missiles with greater than 3,000 km range.
- Fixed or mobile launchers on the beds of the ocean or internal waters.

-- Within the context of an equal aggregate limit for a permanent agreement the U.S. would be prepared to consider:

- Qualitative limitations on strategic ballistic missile forces.
- A program for achieving a reduced level of strategic forces.
- The U.S. would be prepared to propose that there be assurances to the effect that neither side would circumvent the agreement through the deployment of non-central systems.

We also spelled out our proposal for a provisional MIRV freeze:

-- A ban on the development, testing, production and deployment of new and modified MRV/MIRV systems for ICBMs.

-- A limit on the deployment of MIRV/MRVs on each side to those ICBM launchers on which MIRV/MRV systems are operational or which are under construction or conversion for such MIRV/MRV systems as of an agreed date.

-- Appropriate collateral constraints to enhance verification by national technical means.
