- 1. TODAY'S SESSION LASTED FOUR AND A HALF HOURS, DURING WHICH WE HEARD THE NORTH VIETNAMESE RESPONSE TO ALL THE CHANGES WE SUBMITTED THE FIRST DAY. THEY ACCEPTED A FEW CHANGES WHICH WERE SLANTED PRIMARILY IN THE DIRECTION OF PRESERVING U.S. PRESTIGE OR REPRESENTED TECHNICAL IMPROVEMENTS. THEY WERE VERY TOUGH ON ALL SIGNIFICANT SUBSTANTIVE ISSUES, MAKING NO CONCESSIONS ON ANY OF THE MAJOR CHANGES. INDEED THEY GREATLY HARDENED THEIR POSITIONS ON THE POLITICAL CHAPTER, CIVILIAN PRISONERS, AND U.S. CIVILIAN PERSONNEL TO BE WITHDRAWN FROM SOUTH VIETNAM. IN THESE AREAS THEY RETURNED TO EARLIER, SOMETIMES PRE-OCTOBER 8, POSITIONS.
- 2. THEIR APPROACH OBVIOUSLY REFLECTED IN PART THE TYPICAL COMMUNIST TACTIC OF HARDENING THEIR POSITION SO AS TO NEUTRALIZE THE MANY CHANGES WE ARE REQUESTING. NEVERTHELESS IT IS CLEAR THAT WE HAVE VERY DIFFICULT NEGOTIATIONS AHEAD OF US WHICH WILL KEEP US HERE FOR SEVERAL DAYS. WE MEET AGAIN NOVEMBER 22 AT 2:30 P.M. FOLLOWING MY RETURN FROM BRUSSELS WHERE I AM MEETING INDONESIAN PRESIDENT SUHARTO, PRIMARILY ABOUT HIS COUNTRY'S ROLE IIN THE ICCS.

  3. WHILE I WAS ON THE WAY TO BRUSSELS, HAIG MET WITH SOUTH
  VIETNAMESE AMBASSADORS HERE AND EMPHASIZED THE CRITICAL JUNCTURE
  WE ARE NOW IN. HE REVIEWED THE RESULTS OF THE SESSION IN DETAIL
  AND EMPHASIZED THE NEED FOR THE GVN TO FOCUS ON CRUCIAL ISSUES AND

  MENT FOR PUBLIC UNITY AND FAST PRIVATE COOPERATION SO THAT WE CAN—

  FOR THEIR IMMEDIATE VIEWS ON THE ICCS AND FOUR-PARTY MILITARY COMMISS—
  ION PROTOCOLS WHICH WE WILL HAVE TO TABLE IN THE NEXT DAY OR SO. HE
  ONCE AGAIN UNDERLINED THE PRESIDENT'S DETERMINATION TO COMPLETE THE
  AGREEMENT, AFTER MAKING MAXIMUM EFFORTS TO IMPROVE IT. HE
  UNDERLINED THE SERIOUSNESS OF THE PRESENT SITUATION AND THE FATAL
