SITUATION IN VIETNAM: NINETY-FOUR U.S. ATTACK SORTIES WERE FLOWN IN NORTH VIETNAM AND 277 IN SOUTH VIETNAM. THERE WERE 108 VNAF SORTIES IN SOUTH VIETNAM. THIRTY B-52 MISSIONS WERE FLOWN IN NORTH VIETNAM AND THREE EACH IN LAOS AND CAMBODIA. ENEMY TROOPS KILLED IN SOUTH VIETNAM YESTERDAY TOTALED 336.

DESPITE GENERALLY IMPROVED WEATHER CONDITIONS THROUGHOUT
MILITARY REGION 1, ENEMY ATTACKS-BY-FIRE AGAINST MARINE AND
AIRBORNE FORWARD UNITS ALONG THE NORTHERN FRONT WERE REDUCED.
FLOODING HAMPERED GROUND MOVEMENTS IN THE MARINE AREA OF OPERATIONS. SOUTHWEST OF QUANG TRI CITY, ACTIVITY INCREASED IN
THE AIRBORNE SECTOR, PRODUCING GOOD RESULTS; WWO ENEMY T-54
TANKS WERE REPORTED DESTROYED. ARVN GROUND OPERATIONS NEAR
FIRE SUPPORT BASE ANNE RESULTED IN THE DISCOVERY OF CACHES OF
MUNITIONS AND EQUIPMENT. AN UPDATED REPORT ON THE VEHICLES
FOUND YESTERDAY NORTH OF ANNE INDICATES THAT THERE WERE

IN MILITARY REGION 3, TAN SAN NHUT AIRBASE WAS HIT BY 37 122-MM ROCKETS, KILLING EIGHT (ONE U.S.) AND WOUNDING 38 (ONE U.S.), ACCORDING TO A CIA REPORT. TWO HELICOPTERS, ONE TRUCK, AN AMMUNITION STORAGE AREA, AND FOUR BUILDINGS WERE DAMAGED.

INCREASED ENEMY ACTIVITY IN MILITAR CEGBAR 4 WAS C

ALONG THE COMMO-LIAISON ROUTE IN KIEN GIANG, CHUONG THIEN, AND

PHONG DINH PROVINCES. THE ENEMY CONDUCTED GROUND ATTACKS ON FIVE OUTPOSTS WITH LIMITED SUCCESS, IN ADDITION TO SCATTERED ATTACKS-BY-FIRE ON INSTALLATIONS AND OUTPOSTS. FRIENDLY ACTIVITY WAS AT A LOW LEVEL.
