HE CLAIMS THE ASSESSMENT REPRESENTS THE GENERAL OPINION OF SOVIET OFFICIALS IN EGYPT. ACCORDING TO THE OFFICIAL, CAIRD WILL NOT INITIATE MAJOR HOSTILITIES PRIOR TO THE GENEVA PEACE CONFERENCE.
