SUBJECT: EVENING NOTES

VIETNAM MILITARY SITUATION: SINCE OUR LAST SUMMARY, SAIGON FIELD REPORTS DESCRIBE CONTINUED FIGHTING IN THE UPPER HALF OF MILITARY REGION I AND SPORADIC CONTACTS WITH THE ENEMY IN MILITARY REGIONS 3 AND 4.

IN MILITARY REGION 1, TWO ENGAGEMENTS INSIDE AND OUTSIDE OF QUANG TRI CITY IN THE AIRBORNE AREA OF OPERATIONS HAS LEFT 77 ENEMY DEAD WITH ARVN CASUALTIES REPORTED AS ONE KILLED AND THREE WOUNDED.

IN MILITARY REGION 2, THERE HAS BEEN NO NEW COMBAT ACTIVITY REPORTED.

IN MILITARY REGION 3, ARVN INFANTRY ENGAGED THE ENEMY SOUTH OF AN LOC. TWENTY ENEMY WERE REPORTEDLY KILLED WHILE ARVN CASUALTIES WERE LIGHT. EARLIER, 20 ENEMY WERE KILLED FARTHER SOUTH ON ROUTE 13 AS THE ARVN 25TH DIVISION CONTINUES ROAD CLEARING OPERATIONS AGAINST SCATTERED ENEMY RESISTANCE.

THE COMMUNIST DELEGATION RIDICULED U.S. TROOP WITHDRAWALS FROM SOUTH VIETNAM, CLAIMING THAT U.S. FORCES ELSEWHERE IN SOUTHEAST ASIA AND OFFSHORE EXCEEDED THE U.S. FORCES PULLED OUT OF THE COUNTRY. DIKE-BOMBING AND OTHER ALLEGATIONS ABOUT THE BOMBING RECEIVED RELATIVELY SCANT MENTION. SITUATION IN MOROCCO AND DEATH OF OUFKIR: RABAT IS GENERALLY CALM FOLLOWING THE ATTEMPTED ASSASSINATION OF KING HASSAN. THE CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING THE DEATH OF GENERAL OUFKIR ARE STILL UNCLEAR, ALTHOUGH A SENIOR OFFICER IN THE ROYAL MOROCCAN ARMY WITH EXCELLENT ACCESS SAID THAT ACCORDING TO INFORMED WORD FROM THE GENERAL STAFF OF THE MOROCCAN ROYAL ARMED FORCES, OUFKIR WAS IMPLICATED IN THE PLOT AND WAS EXECUTED BY PERSONS UNKNOWN. THIS CONTRASTS WITH EARLIER REPORTS THAT HE COMMITTED SUICIDE.
