HONDURAN DISASTER COUNT: THE LATEST OFFICIAL HONDURAN ESTIMATES PUT AT 7,000 TO 8,000 THE NUMBER OF PERSONS KILLED IN THE FLOODING WHICH HAS FOLLOWED IN THE WAKE OF HURRICANE FIFI. ALL BUT EIGHT OF THE U.S. PEACE CORPS VOLUNTEERS WORKING IN HONDURAS HAVE NOW BEEN ACCOUNTED FOR. THE LACK OF COMMUNICATIONS FACILITIES IN SECTIONS OF THE COUNTRIES IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE INABILITY TO CONFIRM THAT THE OTHERS ALSO ARE OKAY.

POLISH MEDIA BUILDUP FOR GIEREK VISIT TO U.S.: WARSAW HAS ORDERED POLISH MEDIA TO BEGIN INTENSIVE COVERAGE OF THE U.S. IN PREPARATION FOR PARTY CHIEF GIEREK'S VISIT, WHICH BEGINS OCTOBER 8. THE FOREIGN EDITOR OF ONE OF POLAND'S MAJOR DAILIES RECENTLY TOLD A U.S. EMBASSY OFFICER THAT "THERE WILL SOON DE SO MUCH COVERAGE THAT THE U.S. WILL LOOK LIKE ONE OF OUR SOCIALIST BROTHERS." THESE EFFORTS UNDERLINE THE IMPORTANCE THAT GIEREK ATTACHES TO HIS VISIT. HE REALIZES THAT MOST POLES HARBOR FRIENDLY FEELINGS TOWARD THE U.S. AND HOPE'S TO ENHANCE HIS STANDING AT HOME BY THE TRIP AND THE AC-COMPANYING WIDESPREAD PUBLICITY. IN RECENT MONTHS THE POLISH PRESS HAS ACCORDED RELATIVELY FAVORABLE TREATMENT TO THE U.S. IN ITS COV-ERAGE OF EVEN SUCH CONTROVERSIAL ISSUES AS VIETNAM OR CHILE, WARSAW HAS CONSCIOUSLY AVOIDED POLEMICS. IN ADDITION, THERE HAS BEEN EX-TENSIVE AND POSITIVE COMMENTARY ON THE PRESIDENTIAL TRANSITION AND FAVORABLE TREATMENT OF THE RECENT SESSION IN WASHINGTON OF THE U.S.-POLISH TRADE COMMISSION.

INDOCHINA SITUATION: THE COMMUNISTS ARE CONTINUING THEIR HARASSMENT OF SOUTH VIETNAMESE MARINE POSITIONS TO THE NORTHWEST OF HUE BUT MILITARY ACTION IN THE REMAINDER OF THE REGION HAS BEEN GENERALLY LIMITED TO COMMUNIST SHELLINGS OF GOVERNMENT FORCES. MILITARY ACTIVITY CONTINES TO FALL OFF THROUGHOUT MOST OF THE REST OF SOUTH VIETNAM ESPECIALLY IN THE DELTA WHERE FLOOD WATERS ARE INHIBITING BOTH SIDES. RECENT AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY REVEALS THE EXISTANCE OF A POSSIBLE NEW NORTH VIETNAMESE SA-2 SITE WEST OF DAK TO IN THE HIGH-
