KING RAYSAL VISIT TO VENEZUELA: VENEZUELAN MINISTER OF MINES HERNANDEZ ANNOUNCED YESTERDAY THAT SAUDI ARABIA'S KING RAYSAL WILL VISIT CARACAS DURING THE NIRST QUARTER OF 1975. HERNANDEZ WILL MEET WITH SAUDI OIL MINISTER AHMAD YAMANI BEFORE FAYSAL'S TRIP.

BRANDT VISIT TO SDTUGAL: FORMER WEST GERMAN CLZLLOR WILLY BRANDT WILL MAKE A SEMI-OFFICIAL VISIT TO PORTUGAL BEGINNING OCTOBER 19. HE WILL MEET WITH PORTUGUESE GOVERNMENT LEADERS DURING HIS THREE-DAY STAY. BRANDT WAS INVITED BY FOREIGN MINISTER SOARES. THE FORMER CHANCELLOR WILL PROBABLY DELIVER A MESSAGE FROM CHANCELLOR SCHMIDT. WHO IS NOT INCLINED TO PROMISE MATERIAL AID TO PORTUGAL AT THIS TIME.
