SUBJECT: ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ITEMS

GREEK EX-PRESIDENT PAPADOPOULOS AND OTHER JUNTA LEADERS ARRESTED: EX-PRESIDENT GEORGE PAPADOPOULOS AND FOUR OTHER LEADERS OF THE APRIL 21, 1967 GREEK COUP WERE ARRESTED AT THEIR HOMES EARLY ON OCTOBER 23 AND DEPORTED TO THE ISLAND OF KEA. ACCORDING CBTO A RADIO ANNOUNCEMENT, THE FIVE LEADERS OF THE COUP WERE INVOLVED IN CONSPIRATORIAL ACTIVITIES DIS-TURBING PUBLIC ORDER AND SECURITY. PAPADOPULOS WAS PLACED UNDER HOUSE ARREST EARLIER THIS MONTH ALLEGEDLY FOR CONSPIRING IN AN ADDITIONAL DEVELOPMENT RELEVANT TO AGAINST THE STATE. LEGAL PROCEEDINGS AGAINST THE EX-PRESIDENT, THE ATHENS APPEALS COURT IS SCHEDULED TO DECIDE. ON OCTOBER 24 WHETHER TO INSTIGATE CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS ON CHARGES OF HIGH TREASON AGAINST PAPA-DOPOULOS AND OTHER MILITARY LEADERS FOR THE APRIL 21, 1967 COUP D'ETAT.

THE ARREST AND EXILE OF EX-PRESIDENT PAPADOPOULOS AND OTHER LEADERS OF THE 1967 MILITARY COUP ARE DESIGNED TO SATISFY PUBLIC SENTIMENT THAT JUSTICE SHOULD BE DONE AND LEADING PERSONALITIES OF THE EX-JUNTA PUNISHED.

THIS HAS BECOME A MAJOR ELECTION ISSUE. THE DEPORTATION TO A NEARBY ISLAND IN THE AEGEAN IS REPORTEDLY TO ALLOW THEIR EASY ACCESS TO ATHENS FOR TRIAL. PRIME MINISTER KARAMANLIS MAY ALSO BE REACTING TO REPORTS THAT PAPADOPOULOS AND OTHER EX-JUNTA MEMBERS WERE PLANNING TO FORM A POLITICAL PARTY. CHARGES HAVE ALSO BEEN BROUGHT AGAINST GREEK STRONGMAN IOANNIDIS WHO IS NOW UNDER INVESTIGATION.

THE RABAT ARAB SUMMIT: A PREVIEW: LESS THAN TWO DAYS BEFORE THE FORMAL OPENING OF THE ARAB SUMMIT IN RABAT, REPORTING FROM VARIOUS SOURCES HAS BEGUN TO SHARPEN THE FOCUS ON POTENTIAL PROBLEMS IN THE POSITIONS OF KEY PARTICIPANTS, CENTERING AROUND THE CRITICAL ISSUES OF THE PALESTINIANS AND MOVING TO THE NEXT PHASE OF NEGOTIATIONS. AT THE SUMMIT, THE ATTITUDES OF AND

INTERPLAY BETWEEN FOUR PRINCIPAL PARTIES WILL BE IMPORTANT: -- EGYPT/SAUDI ARABIA: SADAT HAS ENDORSED A GRADULALIST APPROACH TO FURHTER SETTLEMENT EFFORT IN THE MIDDLE EAST, AND WILL WORK TO NEUTRALIZE OPPOSITION TO THIS AS WELL AS SEEK A RECONCILIATION OF THE CONFLICTING INTERESTS OF JORDAN AND THE PALESTINE LIBERATION ORGANIZATION (PLO) ON THE ISSUE OF WHO IS TO NEGOTIATE FOR THE FUTURE OF THE JORDANIAN WEST BANK. HOWEVER. SADAT'S ULTIMATE SUCCESS WILL DEPEND HEAVILY ON THE CONTINUED SUPPORT OF SAUDI ARABIA AT THE SUMMIT TO HELP NEUTRALIZE RADICAL OPPOSITION. THE SAUDIS HAVE EXPRESSED THEIR VIEW THAT THE BEST APPROACH TO A SOLUTION IS THE GRADUALIST ONE, AND ALSO SEEK TO RESOLVE THE DIFFERENCES BETWEEN JORDAN AND THE PLO. NEVERTHELESS. THE SAUDIS HAVE SHOWN EXTREME RELUCTANCE IN THE PAST TO EXPOSE THEMSELVES TO OTHER ARAB CRITI-CISM FOR ANY POSITION THEY MIGHT TAKE, AND THEY RECOG-NIZE THAT ON BOTH THESE ISSUES THEY WBULD STEUND ALONE WITH SADAT.

-- SYRIA: THE SYRIANS APPEAR TO BE MOVING TOWARD FULL ENDORSEMENT OF THE VIEW THAT ONLY THE PLO CAN NEGOTIATE FOR THE WEST BANK. THEIR CAMPAIGN AMONG OTHER ARABS AGAINST EGYPT'S GRADUALIST APPROACH MAY ALSO BE SUCCESSFUL.

-- THE PALESTINE LIBERATION ORGANIZATION: THERE IS LITTLE EVIDENCE THAT THE PLO WILL GO FOR LESS THAN A FULL SUMMIT AFFIRMATION OF ITS RIGHT TO NEGOTIATE FOR THE RETURN OF THE WEST BANK.

-- JORDAN: : JORDAN HOPES TO EMERGE FROCDTHE SUMMIT WITH AN ENDORSEMENT TO NEGOTIATE FOR THE WEST BANK, RELYING ON ITS TRUMP CARD THAT ISRAEL WILL NOT NEGOTIATE WITH THE PLO. REALISTICALLY, HOWEVER, HUSAYN MUST KNOW THAT HE HAS LITTLE SUPPORT ON THIS ISSUE; NEVERTHELESS, HE HAS INDICATED THAT IF HE DOES NOT RECEIVE SUCH SUPPORT, HE MAY WITHDRAW COMPLETELY FROM THE SUMMIT AND HAS THREATENED WITHDRAWAL FROM FUTURE PEACE TALKS AT GENEVA. AS REPORTED BY EMBASSY AMMAN, JORDAN IS ENTERING THE SUMMIT IN AN ISOLATED, COMPETITIVE, AND SELF-VINDICATING MOOD.

IF THE SUMMIT IS TO EMERGE WITH A RESOLUTION RECONCILING THE UGRDANIAN AND PLO POSITIONSF AND GIVING EGYPT A MANDATE TO PROCEED WITH A GRADUAL APPRAOACH TO NEGATIATIONS, MAINTAIN AN UNBREACHED POSITION N SUPPORTIOF SADAT.
