SUBJECT: NOON NOTES

MOSCOW STILL REFUSING TO GIVE AGRICULTURAL DATA: THE SOVIETS ARE STILL UNWILLING TO FURNISH THE U.S. WITH ADVANCE ESTIMATES OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION AND TRADE AND APPARENTLY WILL CON-TINUE TO DO SO, DESPITE THE U.S.-USSR AGRICULTURAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT THAT REQUIRES SUCH AN EXCHANGE. THE RECENTLY CON-CLUDED MEETING OF THE U.S.-USSR JOINT WORKING GROUP ON AGRICUL-TURAL ECONOMIC RESEARCH AND INFORMATION REVEALED SUBSTANTIAL DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE TWO SIDES. THE SOVIETS CONTINUE TO SHIFT THE EMPHASIS OF THE GROUPS WORK FROM ECONOMIC INFORMATON TO SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGICAL. THEY ARGUE THAT THEIR CROP ESTIMATES ARE TOO POOR TO RELEASE AND THAT ESTIMATES OF TRADE REQUIREMENTS ARE THE PRESERVE OF THE MINISTRY OF FOREIGN TRADE, WHICH IS NOT THE SOVIETS PROPOSED HOLDING ONLY ICE IRTY TO MHE AGREEMENT. MEETING OF THE WORKING GROUP NEXT YEAR, IN AUGUST, INSTEAD OF AT LEAST TWO MEETINGKUAS SPECIFIED BY THE AGREEMENT. THE MEET-ING IN MID-SUMMER WOULD BE TOO LATE TO PROVIDE ITIMELY INFORMATION THE WINTER WHEAT CROP AND TOO EARLY FOA IPRING GRAIN PROSPECTS.

AUSTRALIA TO SELL WHEAT TO USSR: PRESS REPORTS THE AUSTRALIAN WHEAT BOARD TODAY ANNOUNCED A CASH SALE OF 1 MILLION TONS OF WHEAT TO THE SOVIET UNION WORTH \$150 MILLION. THE CONTRACT, WHICH COVERS ALL CLASSES OF AUSTRALIAN WHEAT, PROVIDES FOR SHIPMENT BETWEEN NEXT MONTH AND AUGUST NEXT YEAR.

MILITARY ACTIVITY IN TURKEY: ALL TURKISH MILITARY FORCES ALONG THE GREEK BORDER, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF ENGINEER UNITS, RE-PORTEDLY HAVE BEGUN TO WITHDRAW FROM THE ADVANCED POSITIONS THEY TOOK DURING THE CYPRUS CRISIS. ACCORDING TO A SENIOR TURKISH OFFICIALS THE WITHDRAWALS BEGAN ON OCTOBER 19. ALL UNITS ARE EXPECTED TO HAVE RETURNED TO THEIR NORMAL POSITIONS IN WESTERN THRACE BY OCTOBER 28.

OF HIS RECENT AID-SEEKING TRIP TO WASHINGTON, TOKYO, AND PARIS, TOLD PRIME MINISTER KHIEM HE WAS DISAPPOINTED WITH THE RESULTS OF HIS TRIP OVERALL, BUT THAT HE WAS OPTIMISTIC THE U.S. WOULD PROVIDE SUPPLEMENTAL MILITARY ASSISTANCE TO SAIGON. THE COMMISSIONER SAID THE GOVERNMENT'S POLICY OF MODERATION TOWARD POLITICAL DISSIDENTS WAS HAVING A FAVORABLE IMPACT ON THE U.S. CONGRESS ANDNOHAT THE AMERICAN PRESS WAS GENERALLY TREATING SAIGON'S HANDLING OF THE SITUATION FAIRLY. HE SUGGESTED THE GOVERNMENT'S LOBBYING EFFORT IN WASHINGTON IN THE FUTURE SHOULD EMPHASIZE THE THEME THAT, REGARDLESS OFNZHETHER PAST U.S. POLICY TOWARD SOUTH VIETNAM WAS MISTAKEN OR NOT, SAIGON'S SURVIVAL WAS NOW AT STAKE.

MARAGES TESEGYPT: THERE HAS BEEN LITTLE DOUBT FOR SOME TIME THAT SOME FORM OF AGREEMENT HAS BEEN NEGOTIATED FOR THE SUP-PLY OF FRENCH AIRCRAFT -- MIRAGE IIIS -- TO EGYPT.

THE EGYPTIANS SHOULD BE ABLE TO ABSORB THESE AIRCRAFT READILY, SINCE THEY FLEW THE LIBYAN MIRAGES DEPLOYED UNTIL RECENTLY IN EGYPT. MOREOVER, ADDITIONAL EGYPTIAN PILOTS HAVE JUST COMPLETED TRAINING ON THE MIRAGE IN FRANCE. THE MIRAGE III HAS BEEN IN SERVICE SINCE THE EARLY 1960S AND, GIVEN THE NUMBER LIKELY TO BE INVOLVED IN THE PRESENT DEAL, CIA ASSESSES THAT THEIR ARRIVAL IN EGYPT WILL HAVE A NEGLIGIBLE EFFECT ON THE BALANCE OF AIR POWER IM THE MIDDLE EAST WHICH STILL LIES FIRMLY WITH ISRAEL.
