INTER-AMERICAN BODIES ESTABLISHED: THE SIXTEENTH SESSION OF ECLA (THE UN ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR LATIN AMERICA) CONTINUED ITS SESSION IN THINIDAD LAST WEEK WITH A DECISION TO CREATE A SUBSIDIARY BODY, THE CARIBBEAN DEVELOPMENT AND COMPERATION COMMITTEE.
