DEVELOPMENTS IN MIGERIA: THE NEW MILITARY REGIME THAT TOOK POWER LAST MONTH IN NIGERIA HAS MADE A GOOD INTITAL IMPRES— SION ON THE PUBLIC BY AVOIDING ANY SUGGESTION OF ETHNIC FAVORITISM SO FAR AND BY MOVING TO TACKLE SEVERAL LONG-STANDING DOMESTIC PROBLEMS! FOREIGN POLICY REMAINS ON THE BACK BURNER FOR NOW, ALTHOUGH CONTINUITY IN NIGERIA'S RELATIONS IS BEING STRESSED. HEAD OF STATE BRIGADIER MUHAMMED HAS TAKENIA HARD LINE AGAINST THE CORRUPTION ENDEMIC IN THE GOVERNMENT AND HAS INDICATED THAT CLOSER SUPERVISION BY THE SUPPEME MILITARY COUNCIL IS IN STORE. IN OUTLINING THE REGIME'S MODE OF OPERATION RECENTLY, HE DECLARED THAT CABINET DECISIONS WOULD BE MADE COLLECTIVELY AND WITHIN GUIDELINES SET BY THE SUPREME COUNCIL. STATE MILITARY GOVERNORS HAVE BEEN ADMONISHED NOT TO TOLERATE GRAFT OR ABUSE OF POWER IN THEIR ADMINISTRATIONS. THEY ARE DISMISS-ING LARGE NUMBERS OF ALLEGEDLY CORRUPT STATE OFFICIALS. THE ECONOMIC FRONT, THE REGIME HAS THROWN ITS SUPPORT BE-HIND THE \$48-BILLION FIVE-YEAR DEVELOPMENT PLAN GOWON INTRO-DUCED LAST APRIL. A. TASK FORCE IS BEING FORMED TO RECOM-MEND WAYS TO CONTROL NIGERTA'S STARING RATE OF INFLATION. NOW APPROACHING 40 PERCENT. NIGERIA'S NEW RULFRS MAY NOT FULLY APPRECIATE THE COMPLEXITY OF SOME OF THE PROBLEMS
