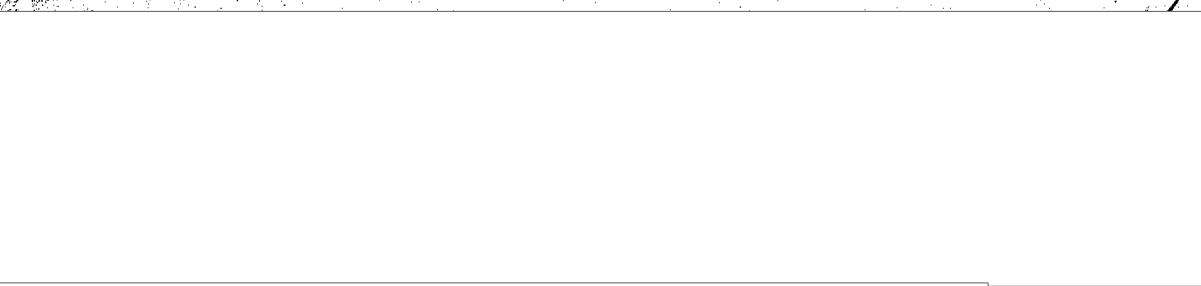

KENYA  
HAS BEGUN CUTTING BACK ON PETROLEUM DELIVERIES TO UGANDA. SHOULD THIS BE TRUE, THE UGANDAN FUEL SITUATION COULD DETERIORATE RAPIDLY. ACCORDING TO DIA, POTENTIAL SOURCES OF PETROLEUM SUPPLIES FROM UGANDA'S NEIGHBORING STATES ARE VIRTUALLY NIL. ZAIRE, ON THE WEST, IS HAVING TROUBLE MEETING ITS OWN DAILY REQUIREMENTS; RWANDA, ON THE SOUTH, IS ALSO DEPENDENT ON KENYA; TANZANIA HAS EXTREMELY POOR RELATIONS WITH UGANDA AND IS NOT LIKELY TO HELP; AND SUDAN, ON THE NORTH, IMPORTS ONLY WHAT IT NEEDS. BECAUSE OF A SEVERE POL SHORTAGE AND UGANDA'S HIGHLY VULNERABLE SITUATION, THE LIKELIHOOD OF A MAJOR MILITARY CONFRONTATION WITH KENYA IS FURTHER DIMINISHED.
