NORTH KOREA: SITUATION REPORT. (U)

1. (S SPOKE) THE SITUATION IN KOREA REMAINS TENSE AS NORTH KOREAN ARMED FORCES CONTINUE TO MAINTAIN A HEIGHTENED ALERT POSTURE, HOWEVER, INDICATIONS ARE THAT UNITS OF ALL THREE BRANCHES OF THE ARMED FORCES ARE RESUMING NORMAL OPERATION. NORTH KOREAN PROPAGANDA CONTINUES TO BLAME THE UNITED STATES FOR THE 18 AUGUST INCIDENT, AND IT HAS ACCUSED THE US OF SENDING A SECOND NAVAL TASK FORCE TO KOREAN WATERS. INDICATIONS OF IMPENDING HOSTILITIES HAVE NOT BEEN DETECTED.

4. (C) NORTH KOREAN UNITS ARE ALSO APPARENTLY INTERFERING WITH COMMUNICATIONS OF US AIRCRAFT. ON 23 AUGUST, THE CREWS OF A P3B AND TWO C-130S FLYING OVER SOUTH KOREA REPORTED ATTEMPTED JAMMING AND COMMUNICATIONS INTERFERENCE RANGING FROM SEVERAL MINUTES TO OVER AN HOUR IN DURATION.
